Phoenix Ireland – Brexit update - Third Country Branch

The United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union at 11pm on 31 January 2020 did not impact your policy or the services we provide.

Following the withdrawal there has been a transition period where the UK aims to finalise a new trade agreement with the EU; this is scheduled to run until 11pm on 31 December 2020 and during this time the UK have continued to adhere to European rules, which includes any pensions or other products that you may have with Phoenix Ireland.

Following the end of the transition period we expect our activity in the Republic of Ireland to be authorised through a Third Country Branch, for which we have approval in principle. This will enable us to provide the same level of service whilst not impacting your policy terms and conditions.

The Third Country Branch authorisation will only take place once the transition period agreed between the UK and the EU has ended.
